

From now on, any person who brings or takes an aggregate amount of foreign currency exceeding USD 20,000 or its equivalent out of or into Thailand shall declare such amount of foreign currency to a customs officer at all Thai customs checkpoints. (Notification of the Ministry of Finance of the Kingdom of Thailand, re: the Regulation of Foreign Currency Declaration for Bringing In and Out of Country, Given on 6th December B.E. 2550, published in Government Gazette Vol. 125, Part 18 Ngor, Special Issue, 25th January B.E. 2550)
